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

## AUR10120 Certificate I in Automotive Vocational Preparation

### What will I gain from completing this VET qualification?

Do you enjoy getting your hands dirty and working on machinery? This course will include eight (8) nationally accredited VET units of competency, which will go towards the Tasmanian Certificate of Education (TCE). It provides a skill set for students that are interested in an Automotive career pathway or just to gain skills and knowledge about workplace safety, using tools correctly and fixing machinery.

Work placement of 40 hours is a mandatory requirement of this course.

VET courses do not support Literacy, Numeracy or ICT ticks.

#### **Entry requirement:**

Interviews will form part of the enrolment and selection process.

#### **Delivery time-frame:**

Over 2 years.

#### Safety requirements:

Safety glasses are supplied by the College. Safety boots are to be purchased before the start of Term 1.

#### What will I learn?

- Identify environmental and sustainability requirements in an automotive service or repair workplace.
- Identify automotive electrical systems and components
- Apply automotive workplace safety fundamentals
- Use and maintain workplace tools and equipment in an automotive workplace
- Identify automotive mechanical systems and components
