MAR10418 Certificate I in Maritime Operations (Coxswain Grade 2 Near Coastal)

What will I gain from completing this VET short skill set?

This qualification applies to people working in the maritime industry seeking an Australian Safety Authority (AMSA) certificate.

The certificate is for operating in Australian waters and permits the operation of a vessel up to 12 metres.

Students gain knowledge on how to operate inboard and outboard motors, survival skills in the event of vessel abandonment, mitigate the risk and be able to fight fires on board a vessel and survival at sea using a survival craft.

To receive the full AMSA Certification, additional requirements must be met including medical, eyesight, sea service and course requirements.

Entry requirement:

Interviews will form part of the enrolment and selection process.

Delivery Time-frame:

Approx. 10 weeks

What will I learn?

Students will gain an understanding of the realities and requirements for working in the Australian Maritime industry, learning in world class facilities and on board vessels.

- Seamanship skills for vessels
- How to command and operate vessels less than 12 metres in length
- How to operate outboard motors of unlimited propulsion power
- How to operate inboard motors of less than 100kw propulsion power
- Maritime safety and emergency procedures
- How to splice rope and tie knots commonly used in the maritime industry

If a student completes the Shipboard Safety Skill Set course prior to enrolment into this qualification, units will be credit transferred.
