# MARSS00008 Shipboard Safety Skill Set

## What will I gain from completing this VET short skill set?

This skill set is Nationally accredited and required if wanting to pursue work on any small commercial fishing or trade vessel and provides the necessary skills for survival on the water.

Students gain skills and knowledge on safety in the event of vessel abandonment, mitigate the risk and be able to fight fires on board a vessel and survival at sea using a survival craft.

Expressions of interest will be organised in 2025.

## Entry requirements:

**Students are required to have adequate medical fitness and have a minimum age of 16 years**

## Delivery Time-frame:

2 days

Dates—Wednesday 7 and Thursday 8 May 2025.



## What will I learn?

Students will gain an understanding of the realities and requirements for working in the Australian Maritime industry, learning in world class facilities.

- MARF027 Apply basic survival skills in the event of vessel abandonment
- MARF028 Follow procedures to minimise and fight fires on board a vessel
- MARF029 Meet work health and safety
- MARF030 Survive at sea using a survival craft

If a student completes the Shipboard Safety Skill Set, units will be credit transferred into MAR10418 Certificate I in Maritime Operations (Coxswain Grade 2 Near Coastal) if selected as a study pathway.
