## (Partial) Commercial Pilot Licence

### What will I gain from completing this VET qualification?

This course is aimed at students who have a keen interest in training for a career as a pilot or in the aviation industry. The course allows students the opportunity to work towards or attain a Private Pilot Licence (PPL).

Students receive approximately 25 hours flight time per year (outside of school hours) at the Launceston Airport and will complete all theory at SBSC with a qualified flight trainer.

The units of competency delivered are derived from the Diploma of Aviation (Commercial Pilot Licence).

Satisfactory completion of this two-year program enables students to receive a Statement of Attainment towards the AVI50222 Diploma of Aviation (Commercial Pilot Licence—Aeroplane).

VET courses do not support Literacy, Numeracy or ICT ticks.

#### **Delivery time-frame:**

2 years/1 full day per week. There is an option to enrol in Year 1 only.

#### **Entry requirement:**

Students are required to have passed a CASA Class 1 or 2 Medical before commencement of flying (prior to the course date) and be 16 years or older.

Interviews will form part of the enrolment and selection process.
