Year 10 Introduction to Construction Pathways

What will I gain from completing this VET short skill set?

Are you interested in developing an understanding of how the Construction Industry works? If so, this taster course provides students with fun practical hands-on learning and knowledge about a wide range of areas associated with the Construction Industry. It will give you an insight into what is involved in the full Construction course in Senior College, if you choose to continue into the full construction qualification. The course will include three (3) nationally accredited VET units of competency, which may go towards the Tasmanian Certificate of Education (TCE), if the student is deemed competent in each unit.

- CPCCWHS2001 Apply WHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry
- CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (white card)
- CPCCOM1013 Plan and organise work

Entry requirement: Interviews will form part of the enrolment and selection process.

Delivery Time-frame: 1 year.

What will I learn?

Learners develop core skills and knowledge, and work, health and safety will be explored in a hands-on way. Employers value a good understanding of work and safety issues, these skills can be transferred into an employment situation. This course therefore, provides students with the opportunity to develop workready skills for life.

Please understand that this is an introduction course only, not a full Certificate. It has been designed as an entry level into the two year VET Certificate II in Construction course in Senior College years. Students will receive a Statement of Attainment for units of competency completed. These units of competency can be transferred into the Certificate II in Construction in Senior College years.
