## Year 10 Introduction to Tourism

### What will I gain from completing this VET short skill set?

If you enjoy interacting with people, problem solving, organising, orchestrating and planning successful events, consider this course. This taster course provides students with fun

practical hands-on learning and the opportunity to experience working in the Tourism and Travel sector.

The introductory course will include four (4) nationally accredited units of competency, which may go towards the Tasmanian Certificate of Education (TCE), if the student is deemed competent in each unit:

#### SITXCCS011 Interact with customers

SITXCOM006 Source and present information CUAEVP211 Assist with the staging of public activities or events

HLTAID011 Provide first aid including (010 and 009)

Entry requirement: Interviews will form part of the enrolment and selection process.

**Delivery Time-frame:** 1 year.

### What will I learn?

Students will gain and understanding of the realities and requirements for working in the Tourism and Travel industry and will develop work-ready skills for life.

Internal and external events will play a major role in understanding the needs of customers, with participation in core customer service activities.

Guest speakers will discuss the significant role tourism plays in Tasmanian state (music, food and arts festivals), as well as national and international levels.

Excursions to events and working in partnership with key stakeholders contributes to real life activities and is a major part of course outcomes.

This short skills set has been designed as an entry level into VET Tourism and/or Hospitality in Year 11/12.
